Welcome to beautiful Twain Harte, we sincerely hope you enjoy your time in this special place and that you have the opportunity to visit us at the lake this summer.

Lake Admission Procedure: On entering the Lake, Renters must check in at the Gatehouse and provide the **name of the rental cabin owner, the property address, or the cabin number provided by the rental company.** Due to COVID-19 related restrictions, Twain Harte Lake is operating with a limited capacity, resulting in reservations being required for Fridays/Saturdays/Sundays and any Holidays. Owners have the ability to make reservations for renters, and walk in availability will be based on ongoing capacity limits. You can check for availability at any time by visiting thlake.org and viewing our “Live Attendance Ticker.”

Fees: Renters are required to pay \$8 per person per day. Children 2 & under will be admitted without cost. Renters may pay for the entry of the entire group for all or a portion of the rental period. Any entry credit balance will be maintained at the Gatehouse.

To Exit and Return on the same day: Persons leaving the lake with intention of returning same day may do so without any further obligation by stamping their hand. Stamp is available at the Gatehouse. Please make sure you are checking out with the Gatehouse if you plan to not return that day, so as to allow others to use the lake.

Compliance: Renters’ failure to comply with the Admission Procedure, payment of fees, or any of the Lake Rules may result in loss of Lake Privileges for the duration of the rental. Additionally, the cabin owner may be at risk for loss of Lake Privileges or loss of Membership in the Twain Harte Lake Association.

Lake Rules

The Board of Directors authorizes the Lake Manager, Assistant Lake Manager, and Head Lifeguard to remove any and all persons for offensive, annoying, or disturbing conduct or for willfully violating these rules. Violation of these rules by any member, their guest or their renter, may result in the member's loss of Lake Privileges or loss of Membership in Twain Harte Lake Association.

General Rules

1. **No food or drink is allowed** on the Lake premises except that which is purchased and consumed at the Snack Shack. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages can be consumed on lake premises or in the parking area, except at Board approved events. Water bottles are allowed.
2. **No dogs and other animals are allowed** on the Lake premises at any time.
3. **No TOBACCO in any form is allowed within the fenced area of the Lake property.** This includes the use of "E-cigarettes", and Vaping. The use of marijuana is not allowed within the fenced area of the Lake property or in the parking area.
4. **Proper swim attire is required at all times for all ages.** Children or babies **that are not "potty trained"** may enter the water if they are wearing a swim diapers/plastic pants with a swim suit.
5. **No tents or Pop-ups allowed.** Shade control limited to standard size beach umbrellas.
6. **No running** on the bridge, on the rock, on the beach or on the rafts.
7. **No loud music.** Music devices must be used with headsets on lake property and the parking area.

Swimming Safety

8. **Children under 12 must be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years or older.**
9. **All swimmers under 16 who want to swim outside the roped swimming areas without an adult must pass a swim test each year.** Lifeguards may require any swimmer to pass a swim test if there is concern about his/her swimming ability and safety.
10. **No diving from the platforms closest to the beach.**
11. **No paddleboards, boats or oversized inflatables allowed inside the roped areas.**
12. **No large, oversized flotation and blow-up toys allowed.** Single mattresses, inflatable rings for children, small dinghy/inflatable boats are allowed. Dinghy or inflatable boats may be secured at east end of lake. **Size guidelines are posted at the gatehouse.**

Other Rules

13. **No swimming under rafts or diving platforms** or between dam edge and swim lane markers.
14. **No Frisbees, footballs or other items that might cause injury or annoyance** can be used on the beach, rock, or inside the roped swimming area.
15. **All directions given by lifeguard staff must be followed immediately.** Areas in front of the lifeguard stands must be kept clear.
16. **Entrance to the Lake for Members and Guests** shall be through the Gatehouse only. **Hand stamp is available for same day reentry.**
17. **Spaces for sunbathing on the Beach and Rock are on a first-come basis.** If spaces are left unoccupied for more than 90 minutes, towels and chairs may be removed by members of the lake staff.
18. **Fishing is for children 16 years and under** with a limit of 3 fish per person or 5 per family. Fishing is not allowed in any area where swimmers are present or in the east end of the lake beyond the buoy. Fishing is allowed from the dam after 6:00 pm. Please secure all hooks and tackle on fishing equipment to avoid any injuries.
19. **No unmanned aerial vehicles are allowed on lake property** between Memorial Day Weekend and Labor Day Weekend.
20. **No business operation of any kind is allowed** without permission of the Twain Harte Lake Association Board of Directors.
21. **Twain Harte Lake Association is not responsible for lost or stolen** items including chairs and other beach items that are stored on or near the pipe racks provided for the convenience of members. Items improperly stored may be discarded at any time. Items left at the end of the season may be removed and discarded by members of the lake staff.
